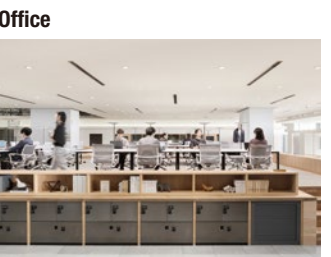
e-Sports

Manga and Light Novel Library
The library has about 37,000 books, including light novels, comics and children's books from the KADOKAWA Group and other publishers. It is Japan's only light novel archive.

EJ Anime Museum
The museum introduces outstanding pieces of content across genres from a unique angle and perspective, including live-action films, video games, manga, and of course the pride of Japanese culture — anime. With a focus on pop culture, which is at the root of the national Cool Japan branding, this one-of-a-kind facility presents displays with a degree of freedom unmatched by other museums and art galleries. *EJ: Entertainment Japan



Bookshelf Theater
Its walls lined with eight-meter-tall bookshelves, including items from the private collections of Genyoshi Kadokawa, Kenkichi Yamamoto, Rizo Takeuchi, and Shuzen Hokama alongside KADOKAWA publications. It also serves as a stage for audio-visual projection mapping events based on the theme of "playing and interacting with books."



Our shrine also offers prayers for the first visit as "Omiyamairi", "Shichi-go-san", and Vehicle Purification.

The worship hall features phoenix-themed ceiling art by Yoshitaka Amano of Final Fantasy fame.

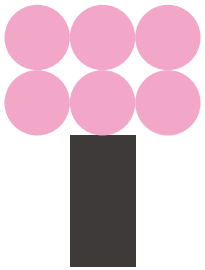


The guardian lion-dogs of the shrine were carved in the image of the Japanese wolf, thought to serve as a guide for the lost.

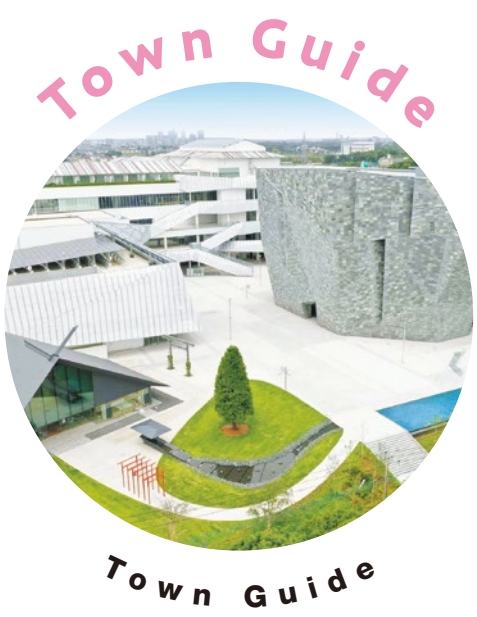


You can also find ema (votive picture tablet) and amulets. The "Amulet for Deadline" and the "Charm for Arts" are special and unique items here.

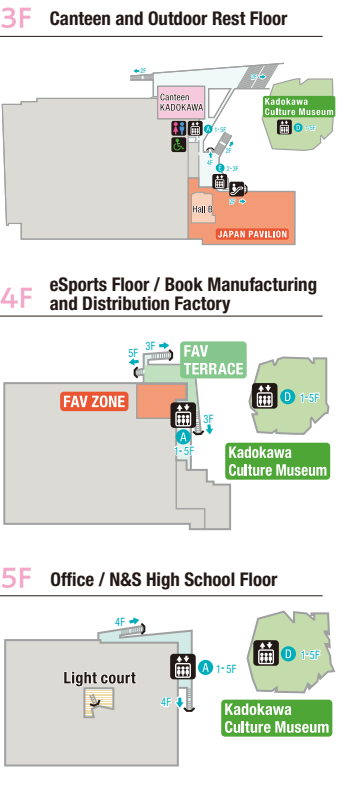
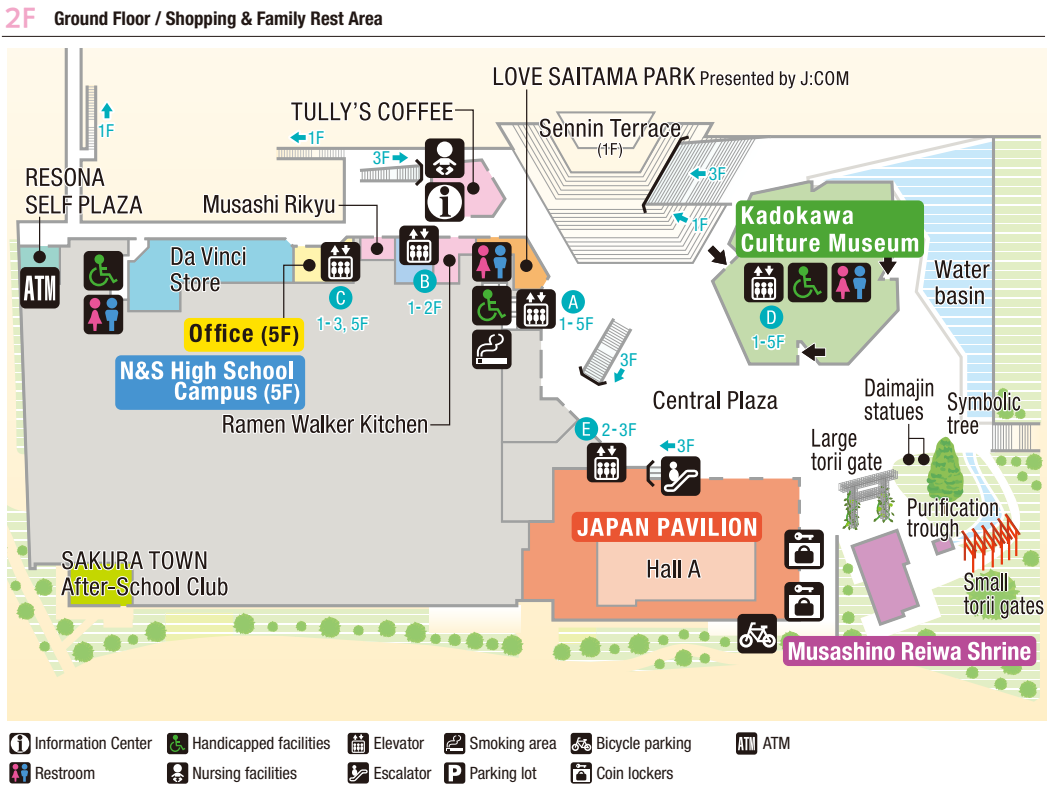
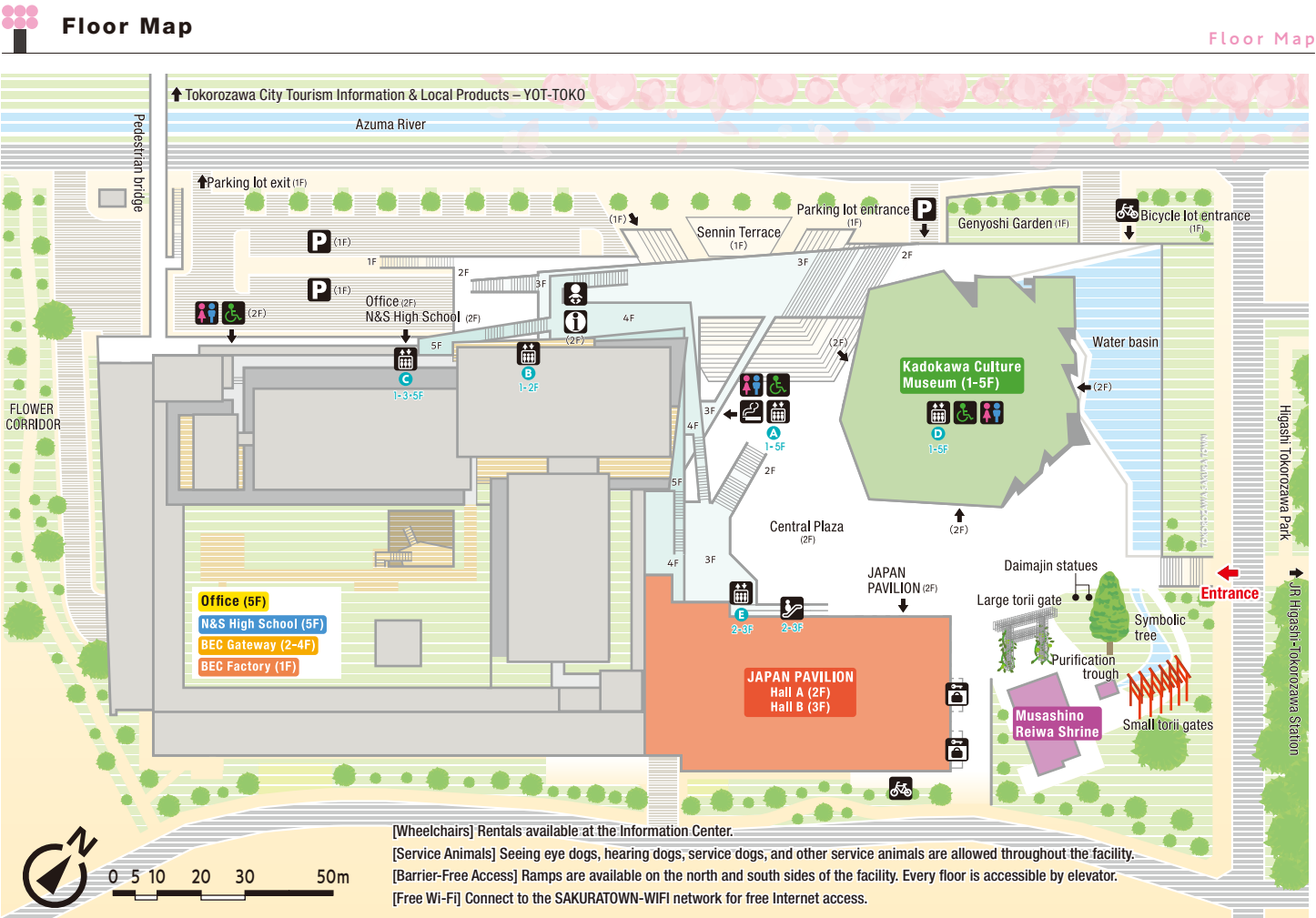
